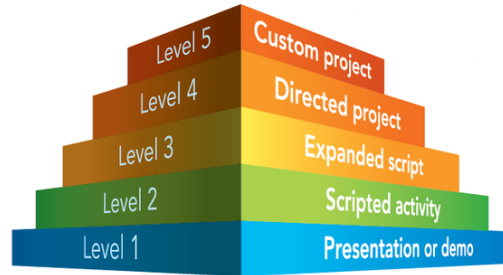


# Introduction to GIS Workshops
